## SERMON DISCUSSION


### Who Will Fix Me

#### Quotable Moments:

- It's impossible to solve a problem if you don't know what's causing the problem.
- Jesus, I can't fix me, but I believe you can. I give you my life.

#### Key Things You Heard:

- While we were still powerless -- Jesus died for us.
- The solution is not a "WHAT" -- the solution for why I can't do what I want to and know I should do is a "WHO."
- Everything Jesus accomplished on the cross has been or can be applied to you!
- Sin Is NOT My Master!



#### Questions for Group Discussion:

**First Minutes:** Based on the first two weeks of this series, how has your view of your sin changed?

- Have you ever felt like you couldn't live up to someone else's standard? Maybe it was a boss, or a parent, or a friend. How did that affect your relationship with that person?
- Read Romans 7:15, 18-19, 24. How have you experienced this in your life? Is there a word other than "wretched" you would use to describe this tension?
- Read Romans 7:25. When using the word "delivers", what is he referring to?
- Have someone summarize the Adam's line/Christ's Line diagram to the left. What is the significance of "your part" and "God's part"?
- Paul said, "Jesus paid the penalty for our sin and broke the power of sin over us." How did he break the power of sin over us?
- Read Romans 6:14. How does the legal transaction of adoption illustrate our new identity spiritually?
- Discuss how we can remind ourselves of our new identity of being "In Christ". How does this new identity help free us from the power of sin?

**Pray:** Jesus, thank you for providing a way for me to have a relationship with God, through your death on the cross. You took the punishment for my sin and satisfied God's anger towards my sin. Thank you for transferring me to be IN CHRIST. Because of your grace, I can experience eternal life with you. In Jesus' name, Amen.
